Fires in residence hall settings have the potential to spread fire,

What should you do if you find yourself in a fire situation?

- Feel the door for heat before opening
- Close the door behind you
- Crawl low to the floor if there is smoke
- Don't look for other people or gather any items
- Pull the fire alarm, but only if it is on your way out
- Get out of the building and then call public safety (x3333)
- If you can't get out, get someone's attention
- Provide information to public safety and local fire department if you can
